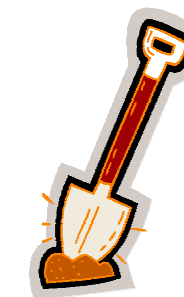

Did You Know:

1. There are FREE lunches at Pleasant View Elementary School for children ages 2-18 at 11:30 AM each week day through July 31? See more information in the Lobby.
2. There is a HUGE need for food at the Christian Action Guild here in Golden and at Jeffco Action Center. They are having to use \$ that would go for utilities, rent assistance, etc. to buy food, because the need is so great. Please give, and give generously.
3. Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+) is a life-saver for families that do not qualify for Medicaid, but fall within the guidelines of the program. It is for children up to age 18, and for pregnant women. It covers well-child check-ups and doctor visits, immunizations, dental care for children, hospital services, prescriptions, mental/behavioral health care and prenatal care. If you or some-one you know does NOT have insurance for their children, PLEASE see Karen or Pat in the church office, or call 1-800-359-1991, Monday through Friday, and see if you qualify!
